
> Ships will gather at Degerby on Tuesday, 12 July where programmes will be arranged for ship crews and others who are interested.

The depth of the channel in to Slemmern Bay is measured at 3.7 m and at the Maritime Quarter 3.4 metres at normal sea level. At Degerby the depth is 5 m outside and 4 m inside the In conjunction with the prize-giving ceremony, ship crews will be invited to a joint celebration dinner.

During the Sea Days, ships will have free berths, electricity and water, and their crews are offered free saunas and showers, good entertainment and enjoyable garrerings.
